WKCTC Reports Increase in Fall Enrollment, Marking **Continued Growth and Community Impact**

PADUCAH, Kv. - Enrollment continues to climb at West Kentucky Community and Technical College, where Fall 2025 headcount reached 5,384 students — a 2.1% increase, or 110 more students than last year. The growth reflects WKCTC's ongoing momentum and its expanding role in supporting education and workforce development across Western Kentucky.

At a time when many colleges nationwide are seeing enrollment

declines. WKCTC's steady EMERGING TECHNOLOGY CENTER

"Fall enrollment numbers continue to rise," said **WKCTC** President Dr. Anton Reece. "This growth
